

MATCH RULES, REQUIREMENTS AND FORMAT

Houghton Lake Sportsmen's Club Pistol NRA Registered Matches

TIMES: There will be 1 relay on each Sunday. Registration will begin **at the range** at 9:00 a.m. Firing will begin 10:00 a.m.

LOCATION: The club is located at 2929 Tower Hill Road in Houghton Lake, approximately 1 mile south of M-55. The clubhouse location is on the corner of Tower Hill & Nestel Roads. The indoor ranges are in the clubhouse facilities. The outdoor ranges are located at 6774 Nestel Road between Tower Hill & Townline Roads.

COMPETITORS: Competition is open to all persons familiar with the course of fire.

ENTRY FEE: Advance entries \$35.00. Junior entries \$10.00. You may enter either the .22 match, Centerfire or 45 matches alone for \$15.00 but squadding preference will be given to those who enter all matches.

ENTRIES: Advance entries are preferred. Call Tom Oakey at 989 275-6050 to pre-register. Leave your name, address and phone number. Advance entries received no later than the Monday before the match will be acknowledged. Entries will be accepted at the range on match day until range capacity is reached. Advance entries can be mailed to: Tom Oakey, 11624 Old 144 Road, Roscommon, Michigan 48653.

RANGE: The range consists of a single 15 position, covered firing line which includes 25 and 50 yards, with electronically controlled turning targets at 25 yards.

RULES: Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will apply. Eye and ear protection must be worn by competitors. The jury system will be used to decide challenges. There is a challenge fee of \$1.00. If the challenge is sustained the fee is refunded.

EQUIPMENT: NRA Rule 3.4 .22 Caliber Pistol or Revolver; NRA Rule 3.2 Any Center Fire Pistol or Revolver; NRA Rule 3.3 Any .45 caliber Semiautomatic Pistol or Revolver

MATCH PROGRAM: Registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. with the match starting at 10:00 a.m. Participants will break for lunch and the match concludes at approximately 4:00 p.m.

- 10.) Aggregate of matches 6-9
- 11.) 20 shots Slow Fire – 50 yards
- 12.) 30 shots NMC – 50 yds & 25 yds
- 13.) 20 shots Timed Fire – 25 yards
- 14.) 20 shots Rapid Fire – 25 yards
- 15.) Aggregate of matches 11-14

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Competitors will be called to the line 5 minutes before the advertised starting times.

3 Minute preparation periods will start at the advertised match times.

Targets will be standard NRA 50 yard B-6 for slow fire and B-8 for Timed & Rapid Fire.

AWARDS: Cash awards to match winners in each individual fired match and high aggregate by class.

Classes with less than 3 competitors will be merged with the next higher class.

Awards will be added to classes after each 5 additional entries.

If there are less than 3 High masters/ Masters combined, they will be shoot for match winner only.

Maximum of 3 places paid per class.

CLASSES: NRA Classes Rule 19.15 Classification card must be presented upon request.

SCORING: Scoring will be done by competitors. Competitors are responsible for providing staplers and posters.

RANGE PHONE: There is no power or telephone on the range.

FOOD/DRINKS: Drinks and snacks will be available at the range.
